Bobby Alexander, President of Pyramid Contracting, said the construction of the clubhouse took on special meaning for him as a member who plans to see his family grow up enjoying all the new amenities. "This was a different kind of project for my company because it was personal to my family, and it was very satisfying to see how my neighbors and friends here in Timberlake came together to support it and make it happen." The party was just a taste of what is to come as the main dining area will be open with a full menu starting on July 10th. The tennis courts are open and pool construction is continuing, and Phase II construction planning is underway. Five new members have joined since the ribbon cutting and several others have committed to joining as well. In addition, the response has been very generous to the TCC "housewarming" gift registry. Items donated include the ladies room wall art, a floral arrangement, framed print, defibrillator. More than \$18,000 has also been donated for furniture, landscaping, golf items, and security surveillance equipment.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction of the new Clubhouse was substantially completed with inaugural occupation of the lounge for the June 17th Social Hour. Construction of the Swimming Pool and Pool House continued this period. Irrigation and landscaping in the pool area is nearing completion and filling of the Pool began on July 17. The goal is for completion of remaining Pool and Pool House activities to enable Pool opening before the end of July. Work on construction “punch list” items is continuing.

FACILITIES & GROUNDS

Our golf course has come to life!! Folks who have not played here in sometime continue to comment to the Golf Shop that they have never seen the course this good in many years.

The greens were recently Verti-cut, top dressed and fertilized. They are coming back super and providing excellent putting. We are also working on the fairways. Fertilizer and weed control; has been applied several times over the past few months, but we have had some problems with fungus and dollar-spot. Those fairways (1,2, 9, and 10) are being vigorously treated and are beginning to come back to good condition.

We are also working on the irrigation system. With the recent hot conditions and little rain, our irrigation system has been working overtime. Unfortunately, it is an old system and is subject to breaks and head failures. However, the preventative maintenance we performed on the main pumps over the winter is now paying dividends as they continue to supply a solid flow. Hopefully, we will get some good rain soon to relieve some of the pressures on the irrigation needs.

Cart path repairs, replacement of the railroad tie borders and selective tree removal remain on our list and are being worked on as time and monies allow.

Two areas our golfers can make a big contribution ---- promptly fixing your ball marks on the greens (in fact, fix two !!) and putting sand in your fairway divots. This will be a huge help in keeping our greens and fairways in to condition
