



## Timberlake Country Club Pool Rules and Regulations

Use of the TCC pool facilities at any time is at the swimmer's own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty. Please abide by the following rules to keep the pool more enjoyable for our members as well as to provide a safe and DHEC compliant environment for all. The pool is for Timberlake Country Club members and their invited guests only.

Hours of Operation: 10:00 am until 8:00 pm daily (TCC reserves the right to close and alter the hours of operation due to inclement weather, special events or maintenance). Advance notice whenever possible will be provided.

- No Diving
- No Solo Swimming
- Children 16 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult
- No running, boisterous or rough play
- Be considerate—No yelling or other loud noises
- No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool
- No smoking is allowed in the pool area
- No spitting or blowing nose in the pool
- Persons with diarrheal illness or nausea should not enter the pool
- Person with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections should not enter the pool
- Person with open lesions or wounds should not enter the pool
- No animals or pets allowed in the pool enclosure
- Glass is not permitted in the pool or on the pool deck
- Swimmers should shower before entering the pool
- A first aid kit is located inside restrooms
- An emergency phone is located outside of the pump room door
- Life Saving Equipment is located on the barrier wall
- Only proper swim attire is permitted (no cut-offs, Bermuda Shorts, jeans etc.)
- Members must provide their own towels. Please use towels to cover the pool furniture
- No floats bigger than noodles or kickboards are allowed in the pool
- Please do not move the pool furniture. Per DHEC rules, chairs must be at least four (4) feet away from the edge of the pool
- Members are not allowed to bring in their own food or beverage (except water). Food is available for purchase at the Purple Martin Grille and Cellar and is allowed to be brought into the pool area for consumption.
- Please place all trash in the proper receptacles
- All TCC members and their guests must sign the pool registry located on the pool fence before entry into the pool area. TCC Members must accompany their guests at all times.
- Green pool wristbands should be worn or in view while in the pool area to assist staff to easily monitor use of the pool by members.
- The life line that provides the demarcation of water depth must be in place during normal pool operation hours. This is an important safety feature and children should not play with the life line.
